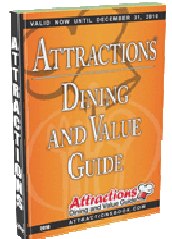

As 2012 ushers in a New Year of evolutionary shifts, consider these questions:

- How will we—as women and as men—engage the inevitable conflicts ahead?
- Can we see conflict as a call for greater intimacy, imagination and relatedness, or will we devolve into familiar patterns of blame, accusations and defensiveness?
- How can we co-create and co-lead in ways that establish Evolutionary Partnership as a strong building block for the future?

An Evolutionary Partnership can develop in any area of life—personal, professional, or social—in which two people agree to:

- ✦ Stand in their power and open their heart at the same time
 - ✦ Approach any conflict as an opportunity to deepen intimacy
 - ✦ Ask "What else could be true?" when faced with polarized thinking
 - ✦ Challenge one another while remaining open and curious
- Speak and listen in an evolutionary way (100% assertive and 100% cooperative)

Evolutionary Partnership/Women & Men (Level 1) is a day-long, experiential workshop designed to provide a safe, encouraging, and empowering space to learn and practice Evolutionary Partnership skills:

- ✦ Speak honestly about your own experience as a man or woman
- ✦ Share collaboratively about what you need from each gender
- ✦ Release old resentments in order to envision the future with clarity
- ✦ Practice forming shared agreements for ongoing Evolutionary Partnerships

Consider gender as a practice field for engaging other conflicts (i.e., race, religion, politics, etc.)

PLEASE NOTE: You do NOT need to be in any kind of partnership—romantic, professional, etc.—to participate at any level of EP/W&M workshops. The purpose is not solving issues of individual relationships, nor is it intended as counseling or therapy.

Facilitated by: *Jane and Dirk Velten became certified in 1992 as facilitators for Essential Peacemaking / Women & Men, a gender training created by Danaan Parry and Jerilyn Brusseau for the Earthstewards Network. In the late 90's, they both became master trainers for this program, training and certifying facilitators throughout the U.S., as well as Europe and Russia. In 2011, they drew on these roots to develop their current program, Evolutionary Partnership / Women and Men.*
