As the hurricane force winds of change twirl around us, it's time to remain centered in the calm and joyful presence that is the I Am That I Am within us. Keep your mind's eye focused on the target of awakening and you will hit the center of your being where you will discover that God dwells in you, as you.

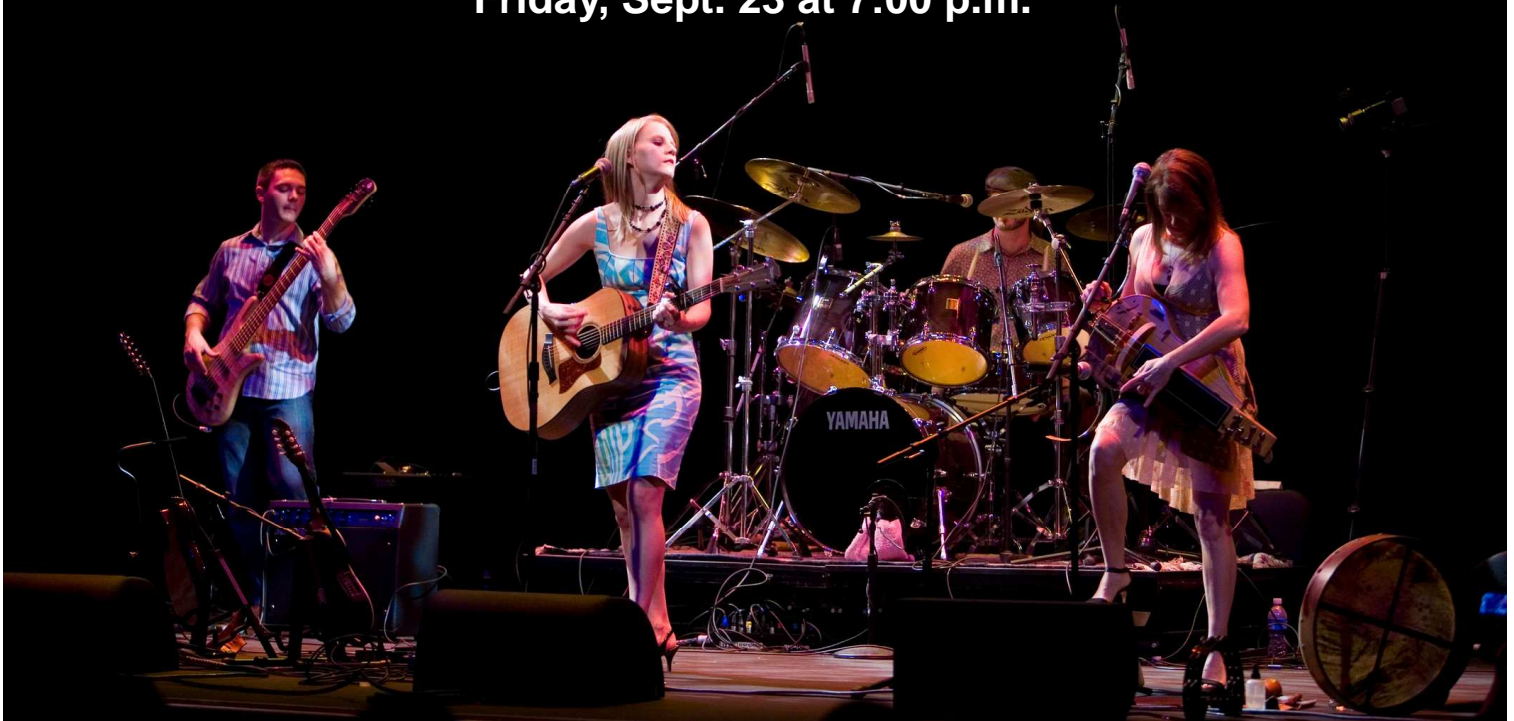

### ***More About Mythica***

Armed with an arsenal of instruments, Mythica will take you on a sonic rollercoaster ride! Influenced by traditional and contemporary Celtic and World music, and by rock artists like Paul Simon,...fresh yet familiar.

Mythica uses the hurdy gurdy (an instrument circa 1100 A.D. from the Celtic nation of Brittany), mandolin, woodwinds, cajon, bodhran and fiddle, as well as non-traditional instruments like the electric guitar, bass and drum kit to produce a musical melting pot tied together with powerful vocals, addictive melodies, and provocative lyrics.

Mythica's popularity is due in part to their songwriting ingenuity. Self-dubbed "Celtic fusionists," the members of Mythica are in their element while fusing Celtic with genres like Breton, funk, and chicha (South American surf rock).

Mythica tours nationally, and since 2005 they have shared the stage with some of the biggest names in the Celtic, folk, and pop/rock markets, including the Spin Doctors, Sister Hazel, Black 47, the Makem Brothers, Celtic Crossroads, and many others.

Meditation is one of Unity's Six Noble Truths, a way to enter the Silence so we may connect with the Divine in a profound way. There are also many other benefits from a daily practice. A meditation practice can bring awareness and stability to one's thoughts and emotions, bringing us more joy and happiness and allowing us to make wise choices—which thoughts and feelings to act upon, which ones to let go. From this place life is experienced from a more loving, kinder perspective.

Richard and Maureen, who have practiced Vipassana, (Insight Meditation) for over ten years, will share some simple concepts about the practice, but more importantly will lead the practice of mindfulness through formal sitting, walking and eating sessions throughout the day. The schedule will include many 20-25 minute sessions of sitting meditation followed by walking meditation. It is a perfect class for beginners as well as advanced students who would like to dedicate a day to mindfulness.

The cost is \$25 for the day, but no one is turned away for lack of funds. Please bring a bag lunch.

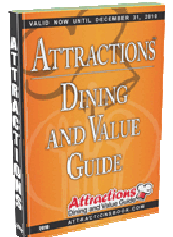

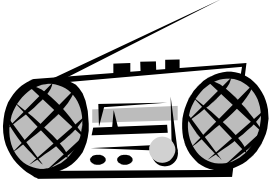
## Community and Worldwide Service
